I'm okay.	Neutral answer. I'm okay, thanks.	Ça va.	9
I'm tired.	To say you need rest. I'm tired after work.	Je suis fatigué.	
I'm happy.	To show good mood. I'm happy today.	Je suis heureux.	
I'm sad.	To show bad mood. I'm sad today.	Je suis triste.	<u>©</u>
I'm angry.	To show you are upset. I'm angry with my brother.	Je suis fâché.	Č.
I'm sick.	To say you don't feel well. I'm sick today.	Je suis malade.	
Thank you	To say thanks. Thank you very much.	Merci	A
Thanks	Informal way of saying thank you. Thanks for your help.	Merci	· ·
You're welcome	Polite reply to thanks. — Thank you! — You're welcome.	De rien	(A)
Please	To be polite. <i>Please sit down</i> .	S'il vous plaît
