Demonstrative determiners

What are
Demonstrative
determiners ?



✓ Demonstrative determiners are words we use before a noun to show which person or thing we are talking.

The four words are:

- **This** → singular, near
- **That** → singular, far
- **These** → plural, near
- **Those** → plural, far

Demonstrative determiners

What are
Demonstrative
determiners ?



✓ We use this and these to talk about things and people that are near us.

We use *this* with singular nouns.

2. This car belongs to my mom.

✓ We use *that* and *those* to talk about things that are farther away from us.

Use *that* with singular nouns

1. This chair is mine and *that* chair is yours.
2. *That* animal is making a funny noise.
3. Would you pass me *that* book, please?
4. Who is *that* man talking to Dad?
5. How much is *that* dress?

✓ We use that and those to talk about things that are farther away from us.

We use *those* with plural nouns

1. I gave my sandwiches to those boys.
2. Those children go to a different school.
3. These shoes are mine and those shoes are yours.
4. These apples look fresh but those apples look rotten.
5. Those people are from Africa.
