

Can	Express ability or permission. <i>I can eat cake now.</i>	Pouvoir	
May	Polite way to ask permission. <i>May I open the window?</i>	Puis-je	
Must	Express necessity. <i>I must clean my room.</i>	Devoir	
Should	Giving advice. <i>You should eat your vegetables.</i>	Devrait	
Go out	Leave the house. <i>I can go out after my homework.</i>	Sortir	
Homework	School work done at home. <i>I do my homework every day.</i>	Devoirs	
Sorry	Apology. <i>I'm sorry for being late.</i>	Désolé	
Apologize	To say sorry. <i>I apologize for the mistake.</i>	Présenter ses excuses	

That's okay	Response to apology. <i>I'm late. – That's okay.</i>	Ce n'est pas grave	 
Excuse me	Polite attention-getter. <i>Excuse me, may I sit here?</i>	Excusez-moi	
Thank you	Show gratitude. <i>Thank you for helping me.</i>	Merci	
You're welcome	Response to thanks. <i>Thank you! – You're welcome.</i>	De rien	
I'm doing...	Present continuous to describe current action. <i>I'm doing my homework.</i>	Je suis en train de...	 
I usually...	Present simple to describe routine. <i>I usually eat breakfast at 7 a.m.</i>	D'habitude je...	 
Every day	Routine expression. <i>I go to school every day.</i>	Tous les jours	
Now	At this moment. <i>I am reading now.</i>	Maintenant	 
Later	After a short time. <i>I will play later.</i>	Plus tard	 
After	Following something. <i>After school, I go home.</i>	Après	  
Before	Prior to something. <i>I wash my hands before dinner.</i>	Avant	 

Can I...?	Asking permission. <i>Can I borrow your pencil?</i>	Puis-je... ?	
May I...?	Formal request. <i>May I open the window?</i>	Puis-je... ?	
You may	Granting permission. <i>Yes, you may sit here.</i>	Tu peux / Vous pouvez	
Don't	Negative command. <i>Don't run in the classroom.</i>	Ne pas	
Must not	Express prohibition. <i>You must not touch that.</i>	Ne devez pas	
Help	Assist someone. <i>Can you help me?</i>	Aider	
Finish	Complete something. <i>I finish my homework at 5 p.m.</i>	Finir	
Start	Begin an action. <i>I start my homework at 4 p.m.</i>	Commencer	
Stop	End an action. <i>Stop talking, please.</i>	Arrêter	
Wait	Stay for a moment. <i>Wait for me!</i>	Attendre	
Watch	Look at something. <i>I watch TV after school.</i>	Regarder	
Play	Engage in fun activity. <i>I play with my friends.</i>	Jouer	

Eat	To consume food. <i>I eat cake on my birthday.</i>	Manger	
Drink	To consume liquid. <i>I drink juice.</i>	Boire	
Clean	Make something tidy. <i>I clean my room every Saturday.</i>	Nettoyer	
Read	Look at and understand words. <i>I read a book.</i>	Lire	
Write	Make letters or words. <i>I write in my notebook.</i>	Écrire	
Sing	Use your voice to make music. <i>We sing Happy Birthday.</i>	Chanter	
Dance	Move to music. <i>We dance at the party.</i>	Danser	
Listen	Pay attention to sound. <i>I listen to music.</i>	Écouter	
Talk / Speak	Use words to communicate. <i>I talk to my friends.</i>	Parler	
Ask	Request information. <i>I ask my teacher a question.</i>	Demander
